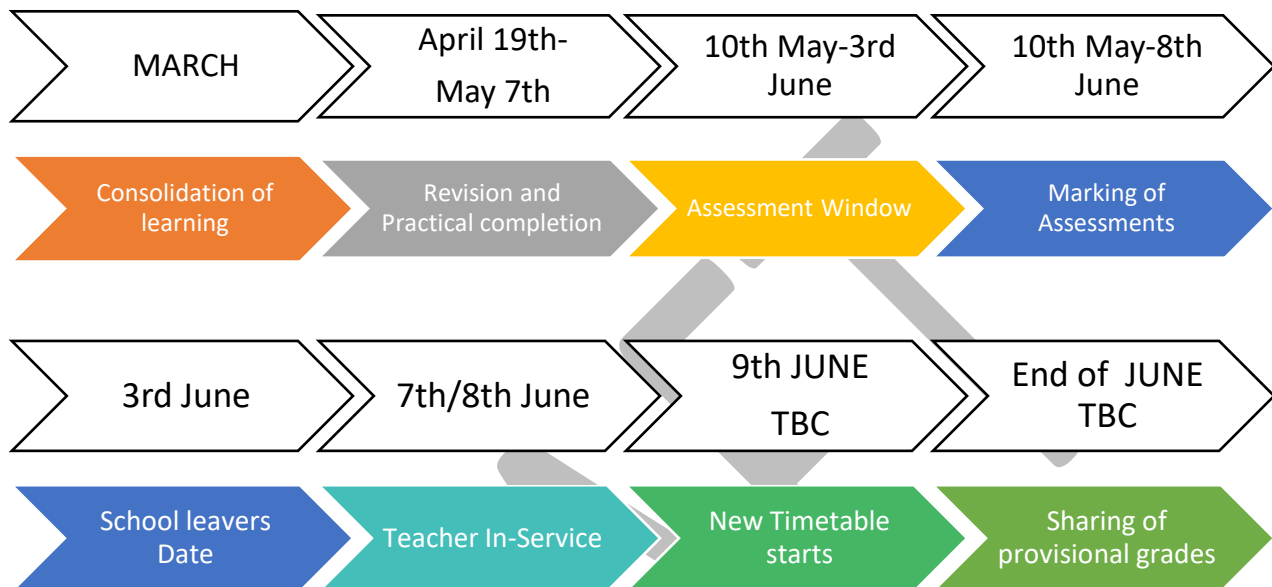




Draft Plan for Summer Term 2021 for Senior Phase pupils

Please find below the plan for after the Easter holidays, with regards to SQA arrangements/assessment windows/timetable changes, etc. Please note that while we hope this will go ahead as planned, this is subject to change if there are further changes at a Scottish Government/ SQA/ Highland Council level.



- **19th-April-7th May-** Pupils in the Senior Phase have returned to school building on a phased return until the end of term. From 19th April, we are hopeful that all pupils will be back in school, to complete any coursework, consolidate their learning, and ensure adequate revision, with support from teaching staff in their normal timetabled classes. This will enable teachers to continue to provide feedback to learners on progress. There may be opportunities for practice assessments in this period.
- **Practical assessments-** Technology practical activities should be completed by 30th April, creative practical activities should be completed by 7th May. (with exception of AH ART, to be completed by 28th May).
- **Final assessment window-** From 10th May-3rd June, each subject will gather and assess learner evidence, carrying out and recording decisions in line with internal quality assurance procedures. I have attached a draft assessment timetable, which will be confirmed on our return in April. Assessments may take place in either the classroom, or a hall, depending on the number of pupils in each subject.

- **Additional assessment arrangements**- these will be in place for all students who require additional arrangements, such as readers, scribes, use of ICT, extra time, etc.
- **Quality assurance**-Our faculties will work with other schools around Scotland to carry out and engage in external quality assurance processes, so there is a consistency between grades across the centre and across the country, based on learner evidence. The school will continue to work with the local authority and SQA through final stages of quality assurance and feedback, to reach provisional results that are consistent, equitable and fair. Two days of in-service have been assigned for this task (7th & 8th June).
- **Study leave**-There will be no official study leave, so pupils will continue to be in classes throughout this period. Teachers will be available to support them in their learning and revision during normal class times. We believe that this will give students the best opportunity to reach their potential in each subject.
- **School leavers**- Pupils who are leaving school should complete a leavers form, once all coursework and gathering of assessment evidence is complete. This should be completed after your final assessment, and by the 3rd June at the latest. Chromebooks (and blazers, if applicable) should be returned at this stage.
- **New school year**-The new timetable will begin on Wednesday 9th June 2021.
- **Release of provisional Grades**-The school will continue to provide ongoing assessment feedback to learners. Provisional grades based on evidence will be issued by the school in JUNE (date to be confirmed by Highland Council). ALL LEARNERS will receive their final certificate from SQA (as usually happens) on Tuesday 10th August.
- **SQA APPEALS**- The SQA Appeal process will go ahead during August 2021. I will share further details when we have them.
